Fall conferences

We absolutely appreciate the time spent in conferences. Thank you for the opportunity to share with you how school is going and all the fun we are having. Just as a follow up to conferences, keep these ideas in mind:

Children Love to Learn

 Provide opportunities for children to explore and learn in the natural environment. Almost anything can be made into a game.

Set Limits

When children do something against the rules, explain simply and in a few words:

- That what they did was wrong
- What will happen if the behavior continues. Consequences need to be logical, meaningful, and simple.

Take Time to Talk and Listen

Ask your child:

- "What was the best part of today?"
- "What was the hardest part of today?"
- What area did you "work" in today?
- What did you sing in music?
- What did you play with in gym?
